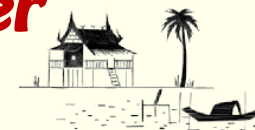

Bible School Area Ladies Revival



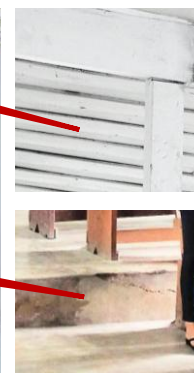

The local District Superintendent and I ministered the two evening services, and two of our lady Bible School graduates and I taught the morning sessions. It is thrilling to see the hunger in the hearts of the ladies for revival services!

Partner funds donated through Missionaries Ed Simmons and Jack Coolbaugh are providing churches! The new church at Sakon Nakhon is nearly complete for use. The fifty year old Chiang Rai church, the first UPC church established in Thailand, is being remodeled. The roof had deteriorated, the floor was concrete on two levels, and interior "temporary" roof support posts had been installed. It will be much more useable with a new ceiling, single-level tile floor, and trusses supporting the roof.
