

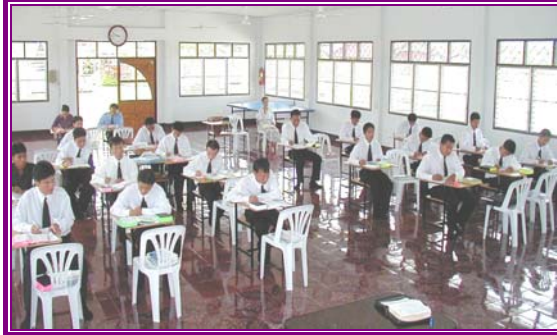


Thailand Bible School Report

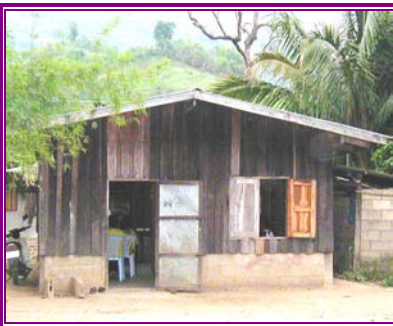
