A wonderful story has been unfolding these past six years of one way the Lord is bringing salvation to people of Laos. The Bible School staff has been traveling into Laos with the Truth, with support and encouragement, and many Laotians are being saved. The photo below is at a baptism along the Laotian side of the Mekong River between Laos and Thailand. **Support from our Partners and UPC Churches of Japan and donations to help build churches from several UPC of USA families of Southeast Asian descent** has made it possible for many people of Laos to come to the Lord.



Baptisms

First to Receive Holy Ghost



- Bible School staff brought Baptism in the Name of Jesus and Infilling of the Holy Ghost to this particular region of Laos – 15 baptized on first trip to Laos!
- Evangelism funds brought Laotian youth several times to Thai Youth Camp and many have received the Holy Ghost – the first Holy Ghost baptisms for this area!
- We helped release an elder minister who was in jail for evangelism, and paid for expenses for him and his son to get government permission to build churches.
- His son is now the leader for ministry in this area of Laos and we have brought him and others to several Thai Ministers Training Seminars and Thai General Conferences.
- We have brought many of the Laotian church people to our area for year-end holiday services, fellowship, teaching and evangelistic services.
- We have helped enable the transfer of donations from USA families of SE Asian descent into Laos (a communist nation) for providing places of worship.
- We have paid for musical instruments and song books, visas for Laotians to travel to Thailand, costs for our staff to go into Laos 4-5 times each year, and much more.
