From Old to New - - - God Blesses Akha Church!



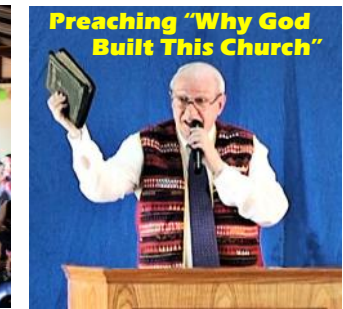
Akha Congregation
